Really Acoustic Textile Felt care

Really Acoustic Textile Felt is delivered as a felt mat, without any surface treatment.

General Cleaning

Really Acoustic Textile Felt absorbs water and should preferably be cleaned with a vacuum cleaner brush attachment, or with a dry cloth. If cleaning detergents are necessary, use a mild household-cleaning product on a soft, damp cloth. Wipe the surface carefully; do not scrub.

Do not leave any water or cleaning agents on the surface. Gently dry wet areas with a soft cloth, so that no water, nor detergents will be left on the surface of the felt. The product will absorb water and detergents, which can lead to fibres rising on the surface.

Do not use any of the following on Acoustic Textile Felt: commercial cleaning products, abrasive cleaners, scouring pads or abrasive papers, solvents, thinners, turpentine, ammonia, bleach, acetone or any other cleaning agents containing either organic solvents or above mentioned products.

Stain removal on Acoustic Textile Felt

If you act quickly, it is not difficult to remove spills and prevent stains from forming.

All loose particles must initially be removed with a vacuum cleaner.

Remove non-greasy stains by carefully dabbing with a clean, lint-free cloth or sponge wrung out in warm water. Edge marks can be avoided by gently dabbing in circular motions towards the centre of the stain. Remove greasy stains by using a mild detergent. In all cases, we recommend testing stain removal agents on an inconspicuous area first, to see if there is any effect on the surface.

Make sure that the Really Acoustic Textile Felt is completely dry before use. If necessary, use a hairdryer to avoid leaving edge marks.

These tips are only recommendations and cannot guarantee complete stain removal.

Warning

Do not rub the material vigorously. This could result in loss of colour or damage to the surface.
